### **UPDATE Covid-19 Test Reports 09/20/2020**

#### **1 POSITIVE COVID-19**

Yakutat Incident Command received confirmation from Yakutat Community Health Center (YCHC) that Yakutat has 1 active confirmed COVID-19 case as of 9/20/20. The Individual was tested on September 17, 2020, and the origin of the spread is unknown, possible communal spread, has gone public with his test.

The Public Safety IC is requesting if you have been in any public establishments / businesses for more than 15 minutes without a mask after September 7, 2020 to be tested as the A-Symptomatic positive showed no signs. All Individuals are asked to please watch pay attention to your symptoms and if you have symptoms please self-quarantine and be tested.

The State of Alaska Public Health has started the tracing and will contact and direct those who have had contact with the positive case. The A-Symptomatic Positive Individual has gone public with his test results and is encouraging anyone that has had contact with him to please be tested, to insure the stop the spread of Covid-19.

Those who test positive or determined to be in direct contact with a Covid-19 Positive Individuals will have a State of Alaska Case Worker assigned. A person that has tested positive or determined to be a close contact cannot have contact within six feet with anyone other than household members that are quarantined with them.

YCHC will be conducting a Drive Thru Covid-19 Free Testing on Monday September 21, 2020 between 12- 3 pm and encourage those who are in question to take the test.

If anyone is showing signs and symptoms of Covid 19 call the Covid Hotline at 784-3010 during YCHC business hours, otherwise self-quarantine and contact YCHC for directions of how they will address your needs. If you are in need of immediate medical attention please call 911 and inform the person answering the phone that it may be Covid related. Any person that is positive or a direct contact of a Covid-19 positive: **WILL BE REQUIRED TO FOLLOW THE CDC & STATE OF ALASKA GUIDELINES. TESTING AND QUARANTINE UNTIL RESULTS OR SELF QUARANTINE FOR UP TO 14 DAYS** or any other guideline requiring a longer isolation.
